### ***Make your voice heard***

All union members at Energex, Ergon Energy and Powerlink will hold a 24-hour strike this Wednesday, 14 May 2008.

The strike is part of our ongoing campaign to secure a better pay and conditions agreement from the three State Government-owned corporations.

During the strike rallies will be held at Brisbane, Maryborough, Gladstone, Rockhampton, Mackay, Townsville and Cairns.

Gold Coast, Sunshine Coast, Ipswich and Toowoomba members attend the Brisbane rally. Bundaberg, Hervey Bay and other Wide Bay members attend the Maryborough rally.

Members not within range of these centres are to commence the 24-hour stoppage at normal start of shift after 6.00am on Wednesday, May 14.

It is important, for your own financial well-being and the ongoing strength of Queensland's electricity supply industry, that we send a strong and clear message to the employers and State Government on Wednesday.

The wages offer of 4.5 per cent per year is not good enough. For a start, it is 0.3% below the Queensland CPI of 4.8% - and safety trade-offs are totally unacceptable.
